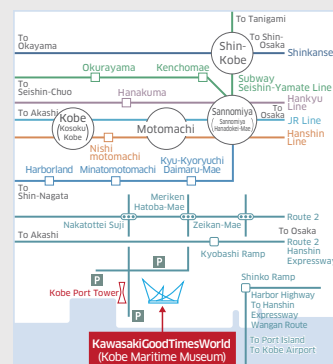
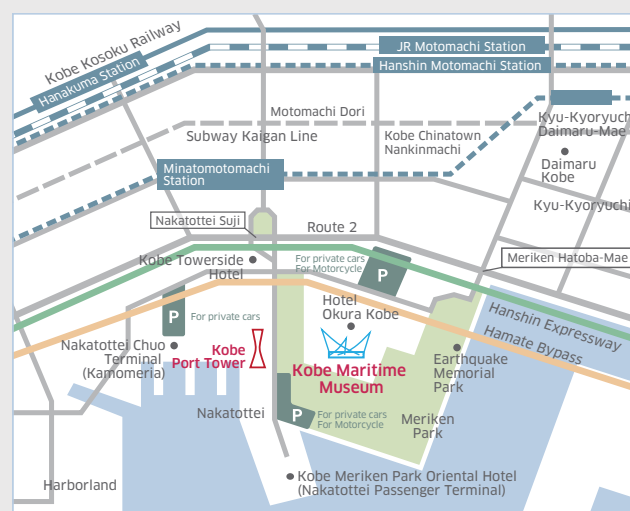

By train

- ◆ 10 minutes walk from Minatomotomachi Station on the Kobe Municipal Subway Kaigan Line
- ◆ 15 minutes walk from Motomachi Station on the JR and Hanshin Lines
- ◆ 15 minutes walk from Hanakuma Station on the Hankyu and Sanyo Lines

By City Loop bus

- ◆ 15 minutes from Sannomiya Station (southbound) —Get off at Nakatotei Pier (Kobe Port Tower) and walk 1 minute

By car / Motorcycle

- ◆ 5 minutes from the Kyobashi Ramp on the Hanshin Expressway
- ◆ 5 minutes from the Shinko Ramp on the Harbor Highway

* Pay parking lots are available nearby.

By taxi

- ◆ 10 minutes from JR Sannomiya Station, Hanshin/Hankyu Kobe Sannomiya Stations
- ◆ 5 minutes from JR/Hanshin Motomachi Stations
- ◆ 15 minutes by taxi from Shin-Kobe Station
- ◆ 20 minutes by taxi from Kobe Airport

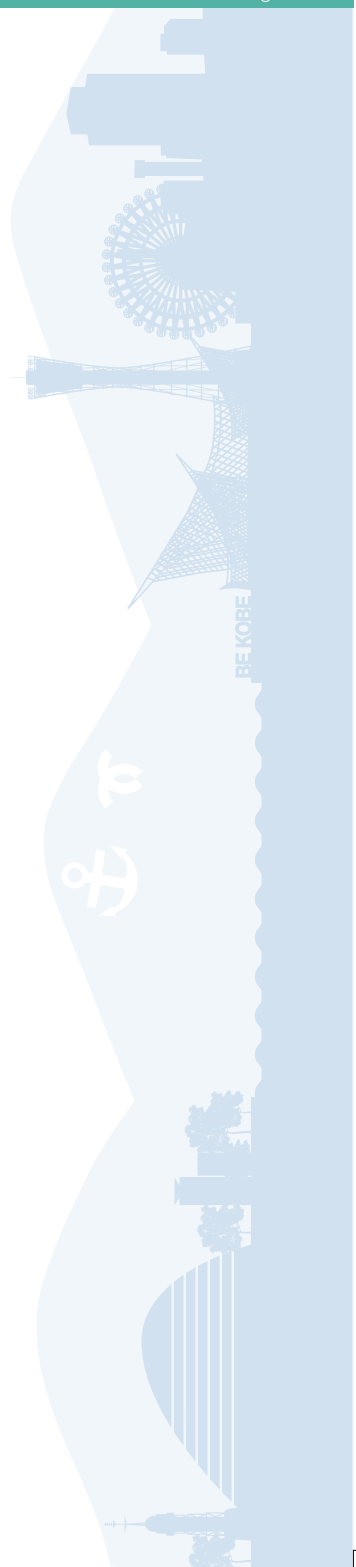

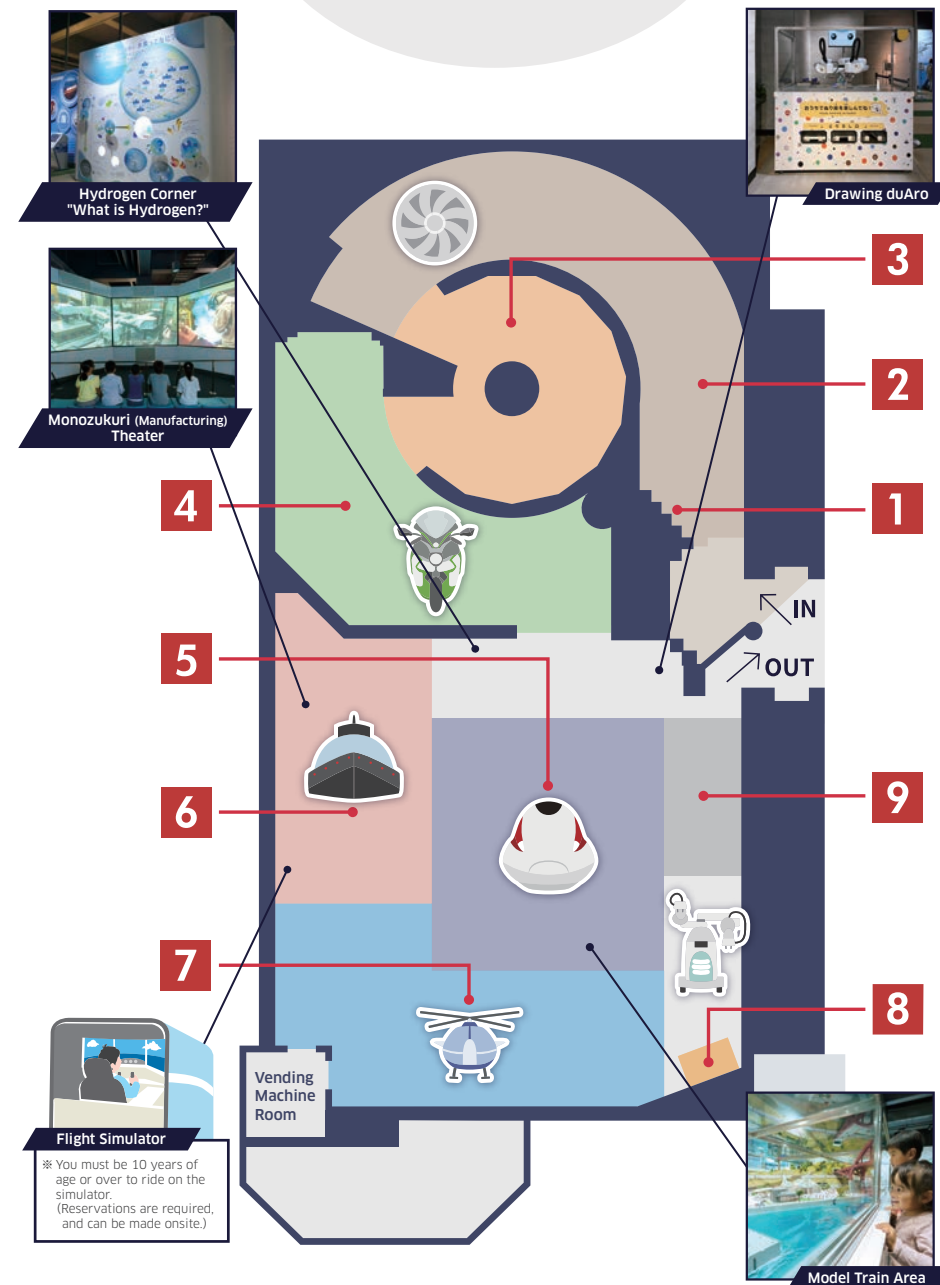

This showcases vintage Kawasaki motorcycles, racing models and many others.



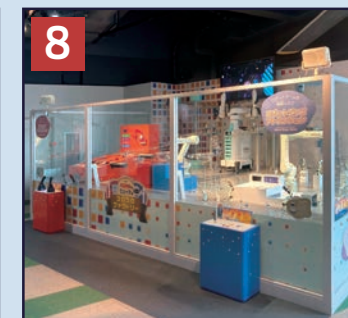
5 Land Zone
